



## What To Do During A Bank Robbery

<u>Dr. Rosemary Erickson</u> is a security expert who trains bank employees in what to do during a robbery. Here are her Dos and Don'ts if you find yourself at a bank during an attempted robbery:

## Do:

- Cooperate
- · Give up the money
- Obey the robber's commands
- Keep your hands in sight

## Don't:

- Resist
- Talk
- Plead
- Stare
- Make any sudden movements
- Be a hero
- · Chase or follow

Dr. Erickson says most bank robberies are over in 90 seconds and only 4 percent of robberies end up with injured victims. Of those, 82 percent are due to someone resisting. Bottom line: Don't be a hero.
